

ELI grants for short stays in Europe

ELI, the European Lymphoma Institute, as part of its mission to promote education and training of lymphoma care givers, proposes to finance short study stays in European lymphoma centers.

The goal for the candidate will be to get acquainted with the working methods, the medical and scientific organization, the schemes of care of lymphoma patients in a foreign hemato-oncology department specialized in lymphoma but also to establish professional and friendly relationships between practitioners caring for patients with lymphoma across Europe.

The candidate

- Young clinical physician in early career, involved in lymphoma care
- Nurse, coordinating a lymphoma activity

The lymphoma center accepting to host the candidate:

- Is in a different European country from the institution of the candidate.
- Is able to welcome and to supervise the candidate. The supervision by a physician/nurse, as a <u>mentor</u>, responsible of the activity of the candidate during the stay has to be provided.
- Proposes a description of the program of the stay.
- Gives the acceptation of the chief of the host department and hospital administration.

The lymphoma center of origin

Gives the request from the head of department

Length of the stay: two to four weeks

Application

- 1. A <u>cover letter</u> from the candidate, describing its objectives (1 page) and the planned dates of the stay.
- 2. <u>Curriculum vitae</u> of the candidate
- 3. A <u>letter from the department of origin</u> supporting the applicant's project
- 4. A <u>letter from the department abroad accepting to host the candidate</u>, supporting the project and committing to provide the applicant with supervision.

Jury

- Three ELI members designated by the committee
- Criteria:
 - Applicant:
 - Motivation in the project
 - Involvement in lymphoma care
 - Host institution
 - Motivation and quality of supervision
 - Presence of a motivated mentor

Budget

- The budget will be provided by ELI. It will contain coverage of travel and accommodation.
- The grant will be paid in reimbursement of these expenses up to a maximum of 3000€ on presentation of supporting invoices.
- In 2024, ELI will offer three grants

The application has to be sent:

- Before April 30, 2024.
